Your Rights

As a data subject, you have certain rights according to the GDPR when your personal data are being processed.

If you want to exercise one or more of your rights as a data subject, you must contact Askerud & Partners in writing via the e-mail address indicated above. Below is a specification of your rights when Askerud & Partners process personal data about you.

Right of access

You have the right to obtain access to your personal data being processed by Askerud & Partners. By contacting us, you can obtain information about the categories of personal data that we are processing about you, the purpose of the processing, the recipients to whom the personal data have been disclosed, etc.

Right to rectification

You have the right to rectification of your personal data if these are inaccurate or misleading.

Right to erasure

In certain cases, you have the right to erasure of your personal data if Askerud & Partners no longer has a purpose in processing your personal data or you object to the processing of your personal data for the purposes of direct marketing or pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR.

Right to restriction of processing

In certain cases, you have the right to restrict Askerud & Partners' processing of your personal data, e.g. if you contest the accuracy of the personal data collected about you or if you have objected to the processing of your personal data based on legitimate interests pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR.

Right to object

You have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to Askerud & Partners' processing of your personal data. You always have the right to object to the processing of your personal data if the processing takes place for the purposes of direct marketing. Askerud & Partners does not transfer personal data for marketing purposes.

Right to data portability

In certain cases, you have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to have those data transmitted to another data controller without hindrance.

Right not to be subject to decisions based solely on automated processing, including profiling

Askerud & Partners does not conduct automated profiling.

Right to withdraw consent

To the extent that Askerud & Partners process your personal data based on your consent, you can always withdraw your consent to any future processing by sending us an e-mail.
